Museum attendance exceeds 1,000 in 2022

The totals are in and we again broke the 1,000 mark for museum visitors in 2022! Based on guestbook sign-ins and scheduled tours, we had at least 1,090 visitors. While we typically open our doors to the public from the middle of May to the end of October, we also open for private tours as our volunteers are available.

Based on being open Wednesday to

Saturday each week, we saw:

- 621 adults
- 318 children
- 151 seniors

Community events also drew visitors to the museum, such as the Ice Cream social during Post Falls Festival and Winterfest.

Some tours came from Camp Kameelin, the summer day camp program offered by the Post Falls Park and Recreation Department, plus members of the Post Falls Chamber of Commerce's River City Leadership Academy.
